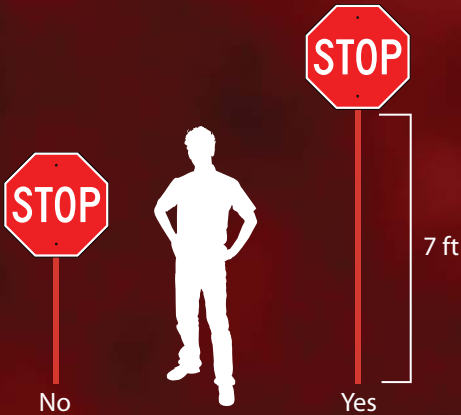


Simplifying New Traffic Sign Regulations For Public & Private Property

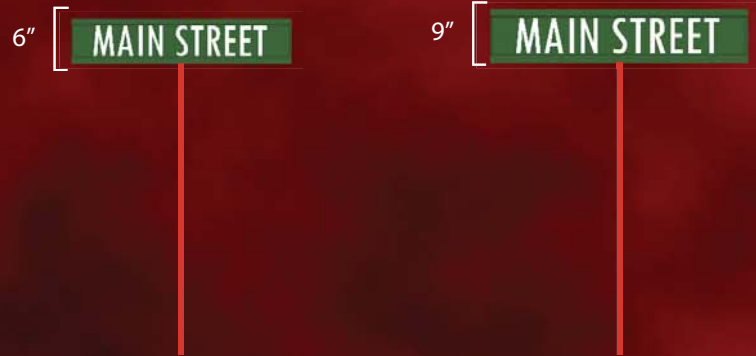


Mounting



Mount sign 7 ft to the bottom of the sign

Street Name Signs



Where the speed limit is 25 mph or less
Use 6" high sign with 4" high letters

Where the speed limit is over 25 mph
Use 9" high signs with 6" letters

Reflectivity Levels

Use Type I
Engineer Grade or Better



for Parking Signs



Grimco Recommends
Using Type III
High Intensity or Greater



for Street Signs or Any Traffic Control Sign



- Why should I worry about this?
- If someone gets hurt on your property with improper signs, you will be held liable.

Time Table

Now	Signs on private property open to public travel must meet MUTCD standards
2012	Larger street name signs should be installed, specifics outlined above
2015	New reflectivity levels should be in place for regulatory, warning, and ground-mounted signs
2018	Street name signs and overhead guide signs must meet minimum reflectivity
note:	Many states and local governments have higher standards, consult with your local agencies
